



PATIENTS at Milton Keynes hospital and prisoners at Woodhill have received gifts of sweets and biscuits courtesy of the city's Muslim community to mark the end of Ramadan.

Community leader Anouar Kassim organised the handout as part of Eid celebrations over the weekend. At the Physiotherapy Department on Monday he distributed biscuits to recovering patients. "It is a custom for Muslims to mark Eid with gifts and it is our privilege to spread that to the wider community," he said.
